Meeting Minutes

1. Funding Opportunities

To receive funding from the Government or any other source, a business must be registered on company's house.

The working group agreed to use "Moxie Energy Group" as the business name, citing Google's definition of the word Moxie – "Force of character, determination, and nerve".

The V2G project will thus be formally run by the Moxie Energy Group.

An application to the "Vehicle-to-everything (V2X) bi-directional charging" will be submitted by May 4th.

The goal is to apply for £350,000 – with 70% being provided by the grant.

Sources to cover the match finding requirement are currently being explored.

2. Potential Learned Society Stakeholders

Adrian Jonas detailed his interest in the venture. To help align Chemical Engineering with the green transition, a perspective shared by the Institute of Chemical Engineers.

Adrian Jonas has been in contact with Prof. D. Friedrich regarding the involvement of The Institute of Energy Systems at The University of Edinburgh. The goal is to engage the Decarbonisation Pathways for Cooling and Heating (DISPATCH) project at the University of Edinburgh with Ulgham's V2G initiative.

3. Marketing Considerations

The consumer perspective was highlighted as a key element of next steps.

The Moxie Energy Group will engage with the village association and the Parish Council to participate in the upcoming celebrations of the Queen's Jubilee.

Moxie Energy Group will use the Jubilee to help spread awareness of the V2G project and help detail how it will impact the daily lives of the residents.
