This is a digitally restored black and white film. Ealing Studios' output from the 1940's and 1950's helped define what is arguably the golden age for British cinema. The film is described as "Loveably Dotty, While Still Smartly Caustic...The Ealing Ethos at its Very Best". "When an unexploded bomb is unexpectedly detonated in Pimlico, it reveals a buried cellar full of treasures including an ancient document proving that the area is in fact part of Burgundy, France and thus foreign territory. In an attempt to gain control the British Government set up borders and cut off all services to the area, but the 'Burgundians' are determined to fight back!"
